The abstract comprises the objectives and the author's contribution to the research topic. It has to contain enough information to make readers able to judge the nature and significance of the topic, adequacy of the methodology, outcomes and conclusions.

KEYWORDS (10pt, bold, italic, capitals, left)

4 to 6 keywords that are representative for the content of the article (10pt, italic, left)

INTRODUCTION (10pt, bold, capitals, left)

It is stated the importance of the topic, the scope and objectives of the paper and it is briefly explained the approach, type of results and the way of reasoning.

The paper should not exceed **8 pages** edited according to these instructions

1. HEADING (10pt, bold, capitals, left)

In the paper's content should comprise state of the art (literature review), conceptual framework, research methodology, results, and discussions.

1.1. Subheading (10pt, bold, left)

For paper editing the following format will be used:

- Format: **A4** (297x210 cm)
- Margins: **2 cm** for all of them (bottom, right, left, top)
- Orientation: Portrait
- The text has to be edited in Microsoft Word 2000, 2003 or 2010.
- Font: **Arial Narrow**, size **10**
- Paragraph:
 - Alignment: **Justified**
 - Indentation: **0 cm** (left, right)
 - Special: **none**
 - Spacing: **0 cm** before and after paragraph
 - Line spacing: **single**.
- The editing will be done in a single column, continuously, without free spaces.

Heading has to be continuously numbered, and the subheading has not to exceed two levels (e.g., 1.2.1.).

All **references** will be cited as follows:

- **one author**: „Demand curve for ecotourism recorded a continuous increase in last decades (Ionescu, 2009).”
- **two authors**: „Corporate social responsibility brings important economic advantages (Panaitescu and Popescu, 2010).”
- **more than two authors**: „Popescu et al. (2001) appreciate that this position is too”;

Page number will not be inserted in the paper.

Pictures & graphs (figures) and tables will be aligned in center, being numbered in the order of their appearance; **black and white** format will be applied.

The number and caption of table will be written in *italic*, centered before the table. The number and caption of pictures and graphs (figures) will be written in *italic*, centered, after the figure.



- Paragraph** for all the paper: **Indentation** (Left: 0 cm, Right: 0cm; Special: **none**); **No spacing before** and **after** paragraph, **Single spaced**.
- Delete** all indications (written in **red**)
- Overwrite** the text as model
