C.3 Narrative CV

I am a university professor, PhD., part of the Department of Statistics and Econometrics within the University of Economic Studies in Bucharest, since 2003, after having gone through all the steps of advancement, starting with the position of university assistant. I have been a doctoral supervisor in the field of Cybernetics and Statistics since 2007, and currently I am the director of the Doctoral School of Cybernetics and Economic Statistics. Also, since 2013, I have been a senior scientific researcher, in the Romanian Academy-National Economy Institute.

Since the beginning of the activity within ASE, as a university assistant, I have carried out research activities within numerous projects, with national and international funding. During these, I dealt with various topics from the socio-economic field, especially topics related to sustainable development, labor market, labor migration, equal opportunities. Also, the research activity focused on issues regarding the quality of life, well-being, migration and labor market. In the activity of doctoral supervisor, I've guided topics of statistical and econometric analysis of the quality of life, labor market, sustainability of socio-economic development. From 2013 until now, I have evaluated numerous project proposals, as a UEFISCDI expert evaluator.

I carried out and am carrying out a rich research activity, within 37 domestic and international research projects, won through competition, of which in 7 projects I had the quality of project director (annex d5). I was also a key expert in research projects. Participating in these research projects strengthened my expertise in areas such as: sustainable development, social cohesion, well-being and quality of life, demographic aging, reducing inequalities, employment and insertion of young people in the labor market, etc.

As the director of numerous projects from public and private financings, I followed and supervised the entire activity carried out during their development, including in the financial-accounting field within the research-development projects. It was also necessary to know the national normative framework in terms of fiscal facilities for research and development.

I have WoS H-Index 8 and Google Scholar H-Index 16.

I developed communication skills, leadership, mediation, empathy, modesty, authenticity, determination. Another important characteristic I looked for was the ability to listen, understand and empathize with the needs, fears and expectations of team members.
