



4TH INTERNATIONAL DOCTORAL AND POSTDOCTORAL CONFERENCE IN THE LAW AND LAW RELATED FIELDS “LEGAL ASPECTS OF ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT” – SPLITLAW 2027

The Faculty of Law, University of Split has the honour to announce the Call for Abstracts for the **4th International Doctoral and Postdoctoral Conference in the Law and Law Related Fields „Legal Aspects of Economic and Social Development“ - SPLITLAW 2027**, which will be held from 13 to 14 May 2027 as a hybrid event:

- on-site (in person) participation (Faculty of Law, University of Split, Domovinskog rata 8, 21 000 Split, Croatia); and
- online participation (via MS Teams).

The conference topics will be focused on the following or related topics:

- Legal consideration of economic contexts and application of legal solutions in practise;
- Improvement of theoretical and practical legal problem areas;
- Challenges of globalisation and Europeanisation of national law;
- Public and Private Law crossing paths in the EU;
- Challenges in maintaining democracy and the rule of law in the EU;
- European approach to digital transformation, digital economy and society - benefits and potential risks of AI technology;
- Challenges and the future of social policy in the EU;
- Cross-border labour mobility as the foundation of the EU market;
- Effective protection of the EU's external borders – prospects and new challenges;
- Cross-border electronic data exchange in the area of judicial co-operation in civil and criminal matters;
- Monitoring of traders and legal protection of consumers;
- Confidence in the judiciary – independence and efficiency of the conduct of judicial proceedings in the context of economic crime;
- Legal certainty and efficiency of public administration - improvement of the investment environment;
- Legal and economic aspects of corporate governance - European companies as a stimulating business environment in the EU;
- Legal and regulatory challenges and barriers to smart, sustainable and inclusive growth and enterprise;
- Corporate governance, financing and auditing.

The official language of the conference is English.

Doctoral candidate - PhD students (R1 – First Stage Researcher) and **postdoctoral researcher – PostDoc** (R2 – Recognised Researcher)¹ from the field of law and other related fields of social sciences or interdisciplinary fields related to law - who have completed an integrated university degree in law or a previous university degree in law or another integrated university degree or a previous university degree in the field of social sciences (economics, political sciences, information and communication sciences, sociology, social policies, social work and other social activities, security and defence activities, etc.) are eligible to participate in the conference.

Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Full Professor are not eligible to participate in the conference (as a participant).

9 December 2026 - Deadline for completing the application form and submitting the abstract

16 December 2026 - Notification of acceptance of the abstract

2 January 2027 - 14 January 2027 (Period for paying the conference fee)²

2 February 2027 - Deadline for submitting the full paper

13-14 May 2027 - Conference dates

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS:

An abstract (up to 500 words with no more than 5 keywords) should be submitted with the application form.

One author can submit a maximum of 1 abstract.

It is not possible to submit/publish an abstract/paper in co-authorship.

Accepted abstracts will be published in the printed version of the Book of Abstracts.

² Paid conference fee can not be refunded! PhD students and PostDoc researchers of the Faculty of Law, University of Split are exempt from paying the conference fee!

After the acceptance of the abstract, each participant will be assigned a supervisor (1. full professor, associate professor or assistant professor from the Faculty of Law in Split; or 2. an external supervisor from the another university units in Croatia who will be available (in-person or online), as an expert in the field of the research topic, to assist the PhD student/PostDoc researcher in preparing, analysing and conducting the research activities, i.e. to refer to the latest relevant sources of literature and relevant jurisprudence at national, European and international level, thus contributing to a more successful scientific and research work of the participants.

After 14 January 2027, participants of accepted abstracts (who paid conference fee) will be provided with the contact information of the appointed supervisor. Contacting the supervisor is voluntary, but recommended.

CALL FOR PAPERS:

Authors of accepted abstracts have the opportunity to submit a full paper (in English) of no more than 10,000 words (including tables and references), which will be reviewed by at least two reviewers. After a double blind review, the accepted papers will be categorised (as a original scientific paper; preliminary communication; review paper; professional paper) and published in a Book of Proceedings (electronic edition) which will be sent for indexation.

CONFERENCE FEE:

ON-SITE (IN PERSON) OR ONLINE PARTICIPATION – 150 EUR / PER PARTICIPANT

The registration fee includes:

- Welcome drink at the conference opening;
- Participation in the opening speeches of the conference;
- Participation in the keynote speeches from the narrow subject areas comprising most of the presentations accepted by the conference participants;
- Attendance at all conference sessions;
- Publication of one abstract in the Book of Abstracts (if the abstract is accepted for publication)
- Book of Abstracts (printed/PDF form);
- One paper presented on-site/online and published in the electronic edition of the Book of Proceedings (if the paper is accepted for publication);
- Book of Proceedings (PDF form);
- A supervisor in the research area of the participant's accepted conference topic;
- Conference programme (printed/PDF form);
- Certificate of participation (after presentation of abstract/paper) – PDF form;
- Refreshments (coffee breaks) during the conference;
- Conference lunch or dinner (for two days);
- free access to library resources and available databases enabling participant to conduct more successful research.

The registration fee does not include accommodation and transport costs.


